Grape: Chardonnay

Vinification: The chardonnay parcel is located on the border of Morgon. They are 30 year old vines and on silty, clay-calcareous soils. The grapes are harvested in September. The wine is pressed and vinified and aged in inox. The elevage is 4 months on fine lees.

About the Producer: Karim Vionnet is a rising star of Beaujolais. Karim was a baker before he decided to follow his passion and become a winemaker. He worked under Guy Breton (famous "gang of four" member with Lapierre, Folliard and Thevenet) for 5 years before establishing his own domain in 2006 in Villie-Morgon, also his birthplace. From his 5ha domain, Karim's aim is to "make a wine that is simple and natural". Unnecessary intervention and artifices, both in the vineyard and during fermentation, are avoided, emphasizing high quality and terroir driven wines. This ethos stems from his 5 years working with Guy Breton.
