

La Ferme Rouge 'Les Gris' rosé 2021 (organic practices)

Grape: 100% Old vine Cinsault

Region: Zaër, Morocco

Vinification: Cinsault from 40 year old vines. Cold maceration to retain aromas and freshness and fermentation in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperatures. Use of sorghum as a cover crop during the winter. Dry farming.

About the Estate: Encompassing vineyards and olive trees, this 300 ha domaine is located in the heart of the AOG Zaër, 30 miles from the ocean and the coastal city of Rabat, amidst a succession of rolling hills. 450 meters above sea level, La Ferme Rouge is bordered to the west by the valleys of Wadi Korifla and to the south by the foothills of the Middle Atlas. It benefits year round from a strong Atlantic influence and enjoys an exceptional soil, from ancient sands to red clay (iron), limestone, shale and finally, the rich Tirs soils.
